

Reform Club Entrance Fees and Annual Subscriptions
Effective as at 1st January 2020

(Entrance Fees and Annual Subscriptions are inclusive of V.A.T. and are subject to change from time to time.)

A.1. The amounts of Entrance Fee and Annual Subscription payable by Members shall be as follows:

(a) ORDINARY MEMBERS:

Entrance Fee	£1,500-00
Annual Subscription	£1,821-00

Subject to the following exceptions:

- (i) The first subscription of any Ordinary Member elected between 1st April and 30th November in any year shall be reduced in proportion to the number of quarters in that year already expired; and the first subscription of an Ordinary Member elected in December 2020 shall become due on 1st January 2021.
- (ii) An Ordinary Member under the age of 35 years at the date of their election or who is the child or grandchild of a Member shall not be required to pay an Entrance Fee. Any Ordinary Member who is under the age of 35 years on 1st January in any year shall, for that year, pay a subscription of £1,456-80. Any Ordinary Member who is under the age of 30 years on 1st January in any year shall, for that year, pay a subscription of £1,092-60. Any Ordinary Member who is under the age of 25 years on 1st January in any year shall, for that year, pay a subscription of £546-00. Members under the age of 41 elected prior to 1st January 2020 shall continue to pay a subscription under the provisions of Regulation A effective as at 1st January 2019, subject to the same subsequent increases in the actual rate of subscription as determined by the General Committee.
- (iii) The spouse of a Member (the Primary Member) shall not be required to pay an Entrance Fee and shall pay a rate of subscription of £1,023-00 or the same as the current rate paid by the Primary Member if reduced under the provisions of A.1.(a)(v), (vi), (vii) or (viii), whichever is the lesser amount. In the event of the marriage/partnership being ended or following the resignation or forfeiture of membership by the Primary Member, then the Spousal Member will no longer be entitled to a reduced subscription at the Spousal Rate and the appropriate rate of subscription is payable from the ensuing year. Should the Primary Member die whilst still a Member of the Club or be forced to resign their membership due to extreme ill health, then at the discretion of the General Committee, the Spousal Rate will continue to apply and the Primary Member's years of membership will be inherited by the Spousal Member in place of their own.
- (iv) The surviving spouse of a Member who is elected within three years of the Member's death shall not be required to pay an Entrance Fee.
- (v) Ordinary Members who are aged 70 years or more may apply to the General Committee for a **reduced subscription** as follows:

- (vi) No subscription shall be payable by any Member who shall have completed sixty years or more of uninterrupted membership.
- (vii) Members elected prior to 1st January 2020 and who had already been granted a reduced subscription shall continue to pay a subscription under the provisions of Regulation A effective as at 1st January 2019, subject to the same subsequent increases in the actual rate of subscription as determined by the General Committee.
- (viii) In special circumstances the General Committee may consider an application for a reduced subscription notwithstanding that the age or retirement condition is not satisfied.
- (ix) An Ordinary Member who temporarily resides outside the United Kingdom may, from 1st January following notice in writing to the Secretary, pay an Annual Subscription at the appropriate rate prescribed for Overseas Members.

(b) **OVERSEAS MEMBERS:**

Entrance Fee (for categories i-iii below)

Annual Subscription for:

(i) those resident in Europe

£1,821-00

(ii) those resident in North America

£1,289-00

(iii) those resident elsewhere overseas

£1,023-00

(iv) Overseas Members elected before 31st December 2000

£1,023-00

(v) Former Super-numerary Members

£624-00

Subject to reductions as at (a)(i) above.

A.2.

The first Annual Subscription shall be paid in full immediately upon a Member's election.

Thereafter, subscriptions payable under A.1.(a) and A.1.(a)(ii), (iii), (iv), (v), (vi) and (viii) shall be paid in full on 1st January or by half yearly instalments on 1st January and 1st July or by quarterly instalments on 1st January, 1st April, 1st July and 1st October **provided that if any instalment shall not be paid on time the whole of the remaining annual subscription shall immediately become due and payable.**

The Entrance Fee becomes due immediately upon election and may be paid in three equal instalments the first upon election and the second and third on 1st January of the two subsequent years.
